Blair Schoeb is a native Oklahoman and serves as the senior vice president of [United Way of Central Oklahoma](#). In this capacity he assists over 260 volunteers in allocating \$11,000,000 to sixty-two partner agencies. He also oversees the writing of the organization's publication *Vital Signs* and several community initiatives, including those that address issues resulting from Oklahoma's high rate of female incarceration.

Before coming to United Way of Central Oklahoma, Mr. Schoeb was instrumental in bringing a new focus to the issues faced by senior citizens through the convening of three Senior Summits. He has spoken on this subject at the National Area-wide Aging Agency Conference and has been recognized for his efforts by the National Association of Counties.

Mr. Schoeb is a member of Class XXV of Leadership Oklahoma City and a graduate of the first Central Oklahoma Regional Leadership Institute. He serves on the board of directors of the National Association of Planning Councils, the Oklahoma Alliance for Non-Profits, and the Youth Leadership Exchange, where he is program cochair of this year's Youth in Action Class.
